

DO'S AND DON'TS FOR TEMPORARY DUMPSTERS

It is our goal to provide you with the best waste removal service possible and to make your experience during this process as easy and enjoyable as possible. By reviewing and following these "Do's and Don'ts" you will help us ensure that the services provided to you meet and exceed your expectations as well as ensure the safety of your family, friends and the general public.

- <u>**DO**</u> be selective where the container is to be placed. Loading or unloading of the container (on/off the companies' truck) may damage inadequate pavement.
- <u>DO</u> identify if your dumpster is for trash material or if it is for yard waste material. These 2 materials cannot be placed into the same container. If your container is for yard waste material, no plastic bags of yard waste are allowed, only biodegradable bags or loose yard waste are allowed. No dirt or rock can be mixed with yard waste.
- **DO NOT** place trash and yard waste into the same dumpster. Trash and yard waste materials must be placed into separate containers.
- <u>Helpful Hint:</u> Items such as ³/₄-inch plywood placed under the wheels of the container when it is delivered may reduce the possibility of asphalt and/or concrete damage. Republic Services will not accept any liability for damage to pavement, which may occur when delivering or removing the container.
- <u>DO</u> allow enough room for companies' vehicle and container to be placed and serviced after container is loaded. No less than 15 feet (width) by 70 feet (length).
- **<u>DO NOT</u>** ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY IN/ON OR AROUND THE CONTAINER.
- **<u>DO NOT</u>** climb on the side of the container for loading.
- **<u>DO</u>** make sure that the weight is evenly distributed when disposing of heavy materials.
- **<u>DO</u>** load the container evenly.
- Acceptable material: Bulk material, bagged household material, Yard waste (no dirt)
- **<u>DO NOT</u>** place unacceptable waste items in the container. *See below.*

Free Liquids and/or Containers containing free liquids, Dirt, Construction Material, Roofing material, Lead Acid Batteries, Tires, Automotive Parts, Medical or Infectious Waste, Appliances, Electronics including but not limited to Computers or monitors, Televisions, Printers or Fax Machines, Paints or Thinners, Chlorine, Compost, Railroad Ties. Special Waste items require special permitting (i.e. Asbestos)

- **<u>DO NOT</u>** let loose debris to stick out of container.
- **<u>DO</u>** schedule your pick-up at least 24 hours in advance.
- <u>**DO NOT**</u> overload the container. Improperly loaded containers may need to be downloaded prior to removal. If you have questions, please contact our office.
