PAL officers will maintain an adequate ratio of staff to children to ensure safety. There will be no more than four participants to each officer. Participants will be provided with masks and hand sanitizer. PAL officers will ensure their vehicles and all sporting equipment is properly sanitized prior to the start of camp daily.

In consideration of the current Covid-19 pandemic, the undersigned acknowledges this addendum release of liability to the St. Louis County Police Athletic League and the St. Louis County Police Department from any illness, disease or infection caused by Covid-19. It's understood that in good faith, the Police Athletic League will try to maintain the health and wellness of all participants.
